What we do for K-12 schools



Curriki Grants helps K–12 schools access powerful, AI-driven EdTech tools that improve learning outcomes—but are often out of financial reach.

We award quarterly micro-grants to support schools ready to adopt these tools and accelerate student progress through personalized, data-informed instruction.

Our first round of grants will launch in **late 2025**. While applications aren't open yet, we encourage interested schools to explore this opportunity and return to our site in **Fall 2025** when the application process begins.

Who is eligible ?

- Curriki is currently awarding grants to:
 - **Public schools**
 - **Charter schools**
 - **Nonprofit private schools**
- We are actively exploring logistics to support **for-profit schools** in future grant cycles, but they are not eligible at this time.

What makes a strong grant application ?

While full criteria will be shared once applications open, strong applicants typically:

- Request an AI tool that is **already approved** by Curriki (or are willing to connect us with the provider to explore approval)
- Serve a student population with **demonstrated financial need**
- Represent **small or mid-sized schools** (rather than large districts)
- Are looking to adopt a **student-facing AI tool** that supports learning outcomes in areas like **Math, ELA**, or general academic growth

- Can clearly explain how they'll **implement the tool**, including device compatibility, LMS integration, and staff support
- Are open to sharing **feedback or impact stories** after the grant
- Understand that Curriki may offer a **one-year follow-up grant** to extend the tool if it proves effective, with a **two-year maximum grant period**

What AI tools are available ?

Curriki is currently in the process of reviewing and approving a select group of AI-powered EdTech tools for grant eligibility.

By Fall 2025, we expect to have an approved list of tools posted on our website. If your desired tool is not listed, we encourage you to reach out—we may be able to review it in time for the first grant cycle.

How the grant process works

1. A school discovers an AI tool
2. They request a quote from the partner vendor labeled with **"Curriki Grant"**.
3. The school submits the quote with their grant application
4. If Curriki approves the grant, the school issues a **purchase order (PO)** to the vendor and becomes financially obligated
5. The school pays the vendor directly and we reimburse the school following payment confirmation.

Our **first grant cycle** will begin in **late 2025**. We anticipate awarding between **15 and 25 grants per quarter** during our first phase.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can for-profit schools apply?

Not yet. Curriki is currently only supporting **public and nonprofit** educational institutions. We are exploring how to expand this in future cycles.

How much money can I receive?

Grant award amounts vary by need and implementation plan. In our first cycle, we expect to fully fund **15–25 grants per quarter**.

Can I apply on behalf of a district?

We are prioritizing **individual schools or small networks**. Large, multi-school districts are unlikely to be funded in the initial phase.

What if my desired AI tool isn't listed yet?

We're actively reviewing and approving tools now. If your preferred tool isn't on our site, we may still be able to consider it—reach out and let us know.

What counts as being ready to implement the tool?

We look for schools that have compatible devices, infrastructure, and staff support to roll out the tool effectively. This isn't about perfection—just readiness.

Do we need to pay for the tool after the first year's grant?

Not necessarily. Curriki may offer a **second-year renewal grant**, but we do not fund tools beyond **two total years**. The goal is to help you prove impact, then build long-term sustainability.
