KEY FEDERAL PRIVACY LAWS



FERPA

(Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)
PROTECTS STUDENT EDUCATION RECORDS (GRADES, ATTENDANCE, ETC.).



COPPA

(Children's Online Privacy Protection Act)
LIMITS DATA COLLECTION FROM CHILDREN UNDER 13 BY ONLINE SERVICES.



PPRA

(Protection of Pupil Rights Amendment)
REQUIRES PARENTAL NOTICE FOR SENSITIVE STUDENT SURVEYS.

AI & STUDENT DATA SAFETY



UNDERSTANDING PII

(PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION)
ANY DETAIL (NAME, ID, PHOTO) THAT CAN IDENTIFY A SPECIFIC STUDENT.



THE AI DANGER ZONE

(PUBLIC/FREE TOOLS)
NEVER INPUT PII. THESE VENDORS LACK A CONTRACT (DPA) TO PROTECT DATA.

SAFE PATHS FOR AI USE



USE DISTRICT-APPROVED ACCOUNTS

USE TOOLS WITH A DATA PROCESSING AGREEMENT (DPA).



DE-IDENTIFY DATA (REMOVE PII)

STRICTLY REMOVE ALL PII FROM PROMPTS & INPUTS.

KEY TAKEAWAY: PROTECT PII. USE APPROVED TOOLS OR DE-IDENTIFY DATA BEFORE USING AI.
